

- American Red Cross Blood Drives

DESCRIPTION:

The American Red Cross Blood Drives have been a part of the mission of WFPC since 1996. We hold three blood drives a year, each with a goal of collecting 80 units of blood. The effort of about 120 donors and volunteers for each drive makes WFPC the second largest church blood drive for Red Cross in the entire Triangle Region. Since June 2000, WFPC has donated over 800 units of life-sustaining blood to the Red Cross.

We are committed to aiding our community with this easily renewable resource because so many families in WFPC have been directly impacted by the availability of blood when it is needed.

Blood Drives at WFPC typically take place in the spring, summer and fall.
