

Gulf Coast Work Teams

Called by God's word to help one another, WFPC sponsors one adult service trip each year to the Gulf Coast. Participants serve residents who were impacted by Hurricane Katrina and Rita through rebuilding, refurbishing and witnessing through action.

The WFPC Gulf Coast Work Team travels to Mississippi to stay in one of many volunteer villages set up by Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (PDA). These PDA villages have been built to receive volunteer work teams from all across the country. They host an average of 1,000 volunteers a month and have a seven year commitment for remaining in the area to continue the rebuilding.

Our WFPC Gulf Coast Work Team members are able to help bring hope and renewal to this part of the country as we help to rebuild, share in God's word and simply remain present for our brothers and sisters who are still in such great need.

Work Teams are sent for about 1 week to Gulfport, MS with dates scheduled through PDA. Typically at WFPC this happens in the spring.
