

# Free Crochet Pattern: Adult's Easy Crochet Hat

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

Finished Circumference About 19 in. (48.5 cm),  
will stretch to fit a range of sizes.



Crochet this one-skein rolled-brim cap in one piece with solid rows of single crochet and just one seam up the back.

- \*Lion Brand Wool-Ease – 1 ball
- \*Crochet Hook - Size J-10 (6 mm)
- \*Large Sewing Needle

## **GAUGE:**

13 sc + 16 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm)

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

## **HAT**

Ch 37.

Row 1: Sc in the 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 36 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn. Working in back loops only, sc in each sc across.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures about 19 in. (48.5 cm) from beginning.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Thread tail through ends of rows along one long edge and pull to gather for top of Hat.

Knot securely.

## **FINISHING**

Seam short sides of piece together to make Hat. Weave in ends.
