8TH

CONFIRMATION is an extensive study of Scripture as applied through the PCUSA denominational lens, with the end -result of a Faith Statement and membership into the WFPC church family as an active adult member through confession of faith.

Specific review of structures of the Bible, in-depth study of the Trinity and other Christian principles, in-depth study of PCUSA traditions and sacraments. Focus on creating a personal Faith Statement that captures the student's understanding of his/her faith journey and preparing for adult membership in the church.

6TH-7TH

Study of Old and New Testament Scripture with specific focus on general application to age-appropriate faith formation questions. Learning specifics to PCUSA traditions. Grow from elementary learning of exposure to stories toward application of Scripture to daily life.
